Incident: Residential Burglary

Report:Cw10-53111

Date/Time: 5/14/10 @ 0930 – 1150 Hours

Location: 2700 block Ashwood Ct.

Synopsis: Unknown suspect(s) burglarized the above listed residence. Entry was made by breaking the lock on the rear sliding glass door. It appears the suspect(s) were startled upon victim's arrival home and left prior to removing property.

Update: On the night of 04/16/10 and the morning of 04/17/10, the City of Belleair experienced a series of spray paint Criminal Mischiefs totaling 10 incidents. While conducting investigative follow-up, Belleair Officers checked local Wal-Mart stores and obtained video of teenagers buying several cans of spray paint earlier in the day on 04/16/10. CPD Detective s also obtained video evidence of the eight Criminal Mischief incidences that occurred on Clearwater Beach the same night where golf balls were thrown at parked cars, causing thousands of dollars in damages. The video evidence obtained from both agencies was placed in several local news papers and media sources. Belleair PD received information on a possible suspect in the Belleair cases. The suspect was questioned and implicated four other suspects. Further information obtained implicated the suspects in the Clearwater cases. On 05/13/10 and 05/14/10, Detectives from both agencies made contact with the five suspects. They were questioned and arrested. A total of fifteen (15) felony Criminal Mischief and twenty five (25) misdemeanors Criminal Mischief charges were made.

Arrested #1: Tyler Bates, DOB: 04/1994

Charges: Criminal Mischief three (3) felony counts and five (5) misdemeanor counts.

Arrested #2: Donald Smolen, DOB: 04/1993

Charges: Criminal Mischief three (3) felony counts and five (5) misdemeanor counts.

Arrested #3: Matthew Howland, DOB: 10/1993

Charges: Criminal Mischief three (3) felony counts and five (5) misdemeanor counts.

Arrested #4: Michael Dedman II, DOB: 02/1994

Charges: Criminal Mischief three (3) felony counts and five (5) misdemeanor counts.

Arrested #5: Brandon Walpole, DOB: 12/1991

Charges: Criminal Mischief three (3) felony counts and five (5) misdemeanor counts.
